



21st Colloque GANIL Strasbourg, 9th-13th September 2019

The 21st Colloque GANIL will be held from 9th to 13th September 2019 in Strasbourg, France.

The purpose of the conference is to review and discuss the research carried out at GANIL and related activities around the world. Traditionally the Colloque will cover the range of topics addressed at GANIL:

- Nuclear structure
- Nuclear dynamics
- Nuclear astrophysics
- Fundamental interactions
- Interdisciplinary research
- Theoretical developments
- Applications
- Instrumentation and technical developments

A poster session is organized on Wednesday evening to allow presentations of all submitted contributions. **The best poster presentation and the best oral presentation by a PhD student will be awarded.**

Sessions will take place in the mornings and in the late afternoon. Longer breaks in the mid-day are foreseen to let participants exchange in a relaxed atmosphere and profit from the city of Strasbourg and the surrounding areas. We ask interested people to stay for the 5 full days of the conference to increase the interactions among the participants.
